Subject: Kleenoil Letter of Recommendation

As a leader in Eagle County in wishing to operate as a greener entity, we continually look for ways to operate more efficiently. In early 2008 Kleenoil came to us asking questions about the oil program in our bus fleet. They introduced their oil filtration system to us, which is designed to have an engine use less oil over its life cycle by keeping it clean. We were interested and worked together with Kleenoil to design a test procedure.



The program started with a complete analysis of our oil program. They tested our bulk oil and the used oil in our buses to establish baseline data. They consulted with us every step of the way to create a comprehensive test program.

We completed a seven-month test in February 2009, and based on great results, ECO Transit made the decision to purchase additional filter systems for several of our buses. These Kleenoil equipped buses will now use and dispose of, 75% less oil. That not only saves substantial dollars in oil costs but also, our mechanics now spend more time addressing mechanical or DOT issues rather than changing oil.



This process is very environmentally friendly and saves the County Taxpayers dollars. We would strongly suggest establishing a rapport with Kleenoil.
